



Selecting your Supervisor

There is much exciting research happening around the Department under the broad areas of telecommunications and signals and systems. The supervisor you have been nominated is a temporary one, and the first three months of your candidature is a time for you to discover different areas of research, projects and supervisors that are available.

For you to become fully aware of all the opportunities available to you, and to immerse yourself in the life of the Department, it is necessary for you to talk to various academics and researchers.

You are required to talk to a minimum of five people each from telecommunications and signals and systems. Below and overleaf is an alphabetical list of all academic and research staff to assist you with this. Both student and supervisor will need to initial the form to show that a discussion has taken place.

Staff members supervising four or more students are not available for supervision.

Once you have decided who you would like to work with, the student and supervisors must sign this form and return it to the Research and Graduate Studies Officer, Ms Debbie Staunton in Room 3.5 who will, if necessary, make arrangements for changing supervision details.
